### Children and Young People Drug and Alcohol Service



At Compass Warwickshire, young people can access a full range of specially developed services and practical support to help them tackle issues associated with their own or another person's substance misuse. The service is free and confidential for people aged up to 25 years old (including an 18-25 transitions service).

#### The service includes:

- Specialist advice, guidance and information for young people around substance misuse and the associated risks
- · Confidential 1:1 and group support
- · Family support

- Hidden Harm young people affected by another person's use

# Adult Drug and Alcohol Service All Age Recovery and Wellbeing



Change Grow Live (CGL) Warwickshire provide a free and confidential drug and alcohol service for adults (including offenders), families, carers and affected others, and a recovery-focused service with a full range of treatments and interventions designed to support people to take control of their recovery journey and achieve their recovery goals.

#### The services include:

- Confidential advice and information about drugs and alcohol
- A tailored package of care for those experiencing difficulties with drugs or alcohol
- Healthcare clinics
- Family and friend support
- Educational group sessions and support
- Support with access to training, employment and housing
- Opiate replacement prescribing
- Community detoxes
- · Needle exchange

Warwickshire County Council also fund residential placements for in patient detoxification and residential rehabilitation.and support a needle exchange and supervised consumption service through a number of pharmacies.

## Drug and Alcohol Residential Rehabilitation Service

Experience Strength Hope (ESH) provides a peer-led residential rehabilitation facility supporting adults who are recovering from drugs and alcohol addiction. The 11 bed facility is operated and managed by professional staff who all have their own personal experience of addiction and recovery.



ESH Community takes referrals from service provider organisations nationwide, local authorities or direct from clients. Prospective residents can make a self referral to ESH Community or work with the staff from the local drug and alcohol support organisation who will have access to funding for the placement.
